- 1 **vir, ī m.** man. **Rōmānus, -a, -um**, Roman. **est**: "is". **fēmina, -ae f.** woman.
- 2 **puer, puerī m.** boy. **quoque** *adv.* also, too.
- 3 **puella, -ae f.** girl.
- 4 **sunt**: "are".
- 6 **-ne**: an enclitic, attached to the end of the first word of a sentence or clause, indicating a question. **parvus, parva, parvum**, small.
- 9 **familia, -ae f.** household. **pater, patris m.** father.
- 10 **māter, matris f.** mother. **Mārci**: "of Marcus" (genitive singular).
- 11 **Iūliae**: "of Julia" (genitive singular).
- 12 **filius, -ī m.** son.
- 14 **filia, -ae f.** daughter.
- 15 **quis?** *interrog.* who? (masculine singular)
- 16 **quae?** *interrog.* who? (feminine singular)
- 20 **qui?** *interrog.* who? (masculine plural)
- 21 **-que**: an enclitic attached to the end of a word = "and" (before the word). **trēs m./f.** three. **liberī, -ōrum m.pl.** children.
- 23 **duo, duae, duo m./f./n.** two.
- 24 **ūnus, -a, -um**, one.
- 26 **servus, -ī m.** slave. **dominus, -ī m.** master, lord.
- 29 **servōrum**: "of the slaves" (genitive plural).
- 31 **ancilla, -ae f.** slave girl. **domina, -ae f.** mistress.
- 33 **duo, duae, duo**, two (masc., fem., neut.)
- 34 **ancillārum**: "of the slave girls" (genitive plural).
- 35 **cuius**: "whose" or "of whom" (genitive singular of *qui, quae, quod*).
- 37 **quot**, how many.
- 39 **centum**, a hundred.
- 40 **multus, -a, -um**, much; many. **paucus, -a, -um**, few.
- 41 **multōrum servōrum**: genitive plurals.
- 42 **numerus, -ī m.** number.
- 44 **magnus, magna, magnum**, large, great. **parvus, parva, parvum**, small.
- 48 **Graecus, -a, -um**, Greek.
- 53 **oppidum, -ī n.** town.
- 54 **tria** *n.* three.
- 59 **cēterus, -a, -um**, other.
- 66 **meus, -a, -um**, mine.
